## Palm Beach Theater Guild - Annual Party and Show "Singing For Sailors and Soldiers"



A Memorial Celebration of Life, Rachel Haruvi.

Rachel Haruvi, 87, passed away peacefully and with dignity surrounded by her son Abe Haruvi and her daughter in law Giovanna Haruvi, in their Palm Beach home on Tuesday, March 11th, 2014, 8:40 a.m. Rachel was born on January 10, 1927 in Lodz, Poland.

She was a **holocaust survivor** who never spoke of the horrors she endured or the loss that she experienced at such a young age. She never let her suffering hinder her life, or her loved ones.

In a very touching tribute, **Abe** shared the story of his heroic mother whose incredible journey uprooted her from her wealthy Polish family life to the atrocities of **Auschwitz and Bergen Belsen**. After the war, she traveled from Palestine to **Israel** and finally arrived in **New York in 1960**.

While in Israel, she met the love of her life; Jacob Haruvi and they **married in 1949**. **Rachel** was the backbone of her family and **gifted them with her strength, wisdom and support.** She also encouraged her children to strive for success.

She had an uncanny gift for reaching out to her son, Abe when he needed her most.

On the evening of her death, Abe received a comforting message from his mother delivered by "two angels." These angels were his mother's caregivers. They told him that his mother wanted him to know that she was grateful for all that he had done for her. That she lived a full and beautiful life with no regrets, and was ready to join his father.

Giovanna Haruvi described Rachel as her Angel. She said it was an honor to know and share her life with her. She felt grateful for the knowledge transmitted to her and for experiencing Rachel's extraordinary love of life.

Giovanna's mother, **Marilia Coser** explained that she shared a love of reading with Rachel. Rachel was an excellent dancer and would not miss an opportunity to dance while Marielia played the piano. She could even dance the tango.

John-John, Rachel's grandson said that she always knew exactly what to say to make him laugh and feel better.

Rachel's granddaughter, Aileen Haruvi read a tribute to her grandmother detailing her life.

Rachel Haruvi is preceded in death by her husband Jacob Haruvi.

Her son Abe Haruvi, his wife Giovanna and their three children survive her as well as her son Arthur, his wife and their children.

The ceremony, presided over by Rabbi Moshe Scheiner took place on Thursday, March 13th at the Star of David Cemetery in West Palm Beach.
