It's Not Too Early to Note These End of the Year Tax Tips

As the year comes to a close, your thoughts more likely turn to holiday celebrations than tax preparation. However, preparing for April 15th should begin now so that the process can go as quickly and smoothly as possible.

Here are a few tips to make reporting easier and lower your tax liability as much as possible:

- Hold onto the records that support items reported on your tax return and prove income and expenses for at least three years.
- If you own a home or investment property, keep records for expenses including home improvements for at least three years after you have sold or disposed of the property.
- You can defer some of your income until the next tax year and at the same time accelerate upcoming deductions into the current year. If you've had a high earning year, this can balance things out.
- Avoid a shortfall by increasing your withholding now. This can help you get caught up before the end-of-year tax tally.
- Decrease your income tax liability by making the maximum contribution to your 401(k) or IRA. This year, that is \$17,500 for 401(k) and \$5,500 for IRA.
- Consider converting your traditional IRA to a Roth IRA, which means you
 can pay tax now on the conversion, but no taxes in the future.
- It's the holiday season, so why not give a gift. Gifts of up to \$14,000 are tax free, and that number goes up when two spouses are involved.

The Evening Featured The Announcement of the George Barley Water Prize, The Largest Science Prize Competition For Clean Water in History While Honoring Award Winning Television Journalist and Conservationist Tom Brokaw, Laughing with Actor/Comedian Jim Gaffigan and Enjoying a Musical Performance by Multi-Platinum Selling Grammy Winner Alan Jackson

"It's Five O'clock Somewhere"... That was the theme for the IIth Annual ForEverglades Benefit, which took place on Saturday, February 13 at The Breakers Palm Beach. The sold out event featured award-winning television journalist, author and Special Correspondent for NBC News, honoree Tom Brokaw; Grammy-nominated actor/comedian Jim Gaffigan; and country superstar Alan Jackson, along with his band, performing mega hits to a crowd of over 800 Everglades Foundation supporters.

Board Chair, Marshall Field took to the stage and invited the crowd to view a videotaped tribute to Tom Brokaw from several of his close friends, colleagues, and fly fishing partners including: Harrison Ford, Jimmy Buffett, Katie Couric, Eli Manning Warren Buffett, Pat Riley and Michael Keaton who praised him in a fun-filled tribute for his advocacy towards conservation and the environment.

After dinner, actor, writer and comedian Jim Gaffigan entertained the crowd with his commentaries surrounding food, fatherhood and Florida living. He had the crowd in stitches with his commentary and the fact that this was the only crowd he had ever witnessed eating fruit out of a boot as The Breakers created gold dusted chocolate boots alongside warm apple cobbler for dessert.

The room took a more serious tone when **Paul Tudor Jones** announced the Everglades Foundation's commitment to tackling the global phosphorus pollution problem through its \$10 million George Barley Water Prize. Named after Foundation co-founder and close friend of Jones, the George Barley Water Prize is the largest science prize competition for clean water in history. The audience was captivated while learning about this initiative and a call-toaction was announced with the help of Quinn Hiaasen leading the charge on how to bid on an iPhone. Over \$350,000 was raised in just minutes.


CHEF JEAN-CHARLES CAUQUIL APPOINTED AS NEW CHEF TO 114 FAUBOURG


