On **Tuesday, April 9, 2019 Javier El-Hage spoke** to a large audience of World Affairs Council members and guests at the Colony Palm Beach Pavilion Room. **El-Hage is the Chief Legal Officer at the Human Rights Foundation.** He discussed Venezuela's Descent into Dictatorship. Javier explained how political freedom and economic freedom have been virtually destroyed in Venezuela. In the 1960's Venezuela was experiencing democracy. However by 2004 judicial independence no longer existed leading to the descent into dictatorship. Today Venezuela, formerly one of the richest countries globally, ranks next to last in economic freedom just ahead of North Korea.


