

As Goodwill Ambassador Michelle-Marie has generated significant public awareness and is meeting with legislatures to strengthen the laws.


"Like all forms of bullying, cyberbullying causes psychological, emotional and physical stress. Each person's response to being bullied is unique, but research has shown children who are bullied are more likely to struggle personally and at school and bullying can lead to thoughts about suicide sometimes persisting into adulthood." Says Michelle-Marie who became extremely passionate with fellow parents at a recent lecture about how important it is to be involved in your children's lives, and making sure to have an open dialogue with your children.

"Communication is vital! If you see your child is acting differently or withdrawn, don't ignore this. **Speak to your child,** make sure everything is all right....ask questions, **tell your child how much you love them and together you can work it out.** Children need to know they are not alone. School should be a wonderful place, not a place to fear. I am a lifetime advocate for children, there is nothing greater than a child and I am deeply committed to protecting our children."

WORLD AFFAIRS COUNCIL OF PALM BEACH, INC 2013-2014 Distinguished Speaker Series



On Thursday, February 20, 2014 Michael Braun spoke to an audience of 150 members and guests of the World Affairs Council of Palm Beach at the Colony Palm Beach Pavilion Room. Braun, former DEA Chief of Operations, discussed in depth The **Growing Confluence of Drugs &** Terror: The Face of 21st Century **Crime.** He specifically noted the effect

of the far reaching tentacles of the Drug Cartel in America, and how the money from drug trafficking is funding terrorism here in America and globally. Drug Cartels and Terrorist Groups have joined forces to create a powerful network of terror and crime, which he labeled narco-terrorism. Braun also discussed the great harm drugs pose to Americans, especially our children and young adults.

Michael Braun retired from the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) in October, 2008, and immediately joined Spectre Group International, LLC, (SGI) as a Managing Partner. SGI supports US government efforts to build strong law enforcement and judicial institutions in the US and abroad. The company has headquarters in Alexandria, VA, and has an office in Kabul, Afghanistan.

Mr. Braun has received numerous awards including the Distinguished Presidential Rank Award in 2007 and the Presidential Rank Award in 2006 and the Secretary of Defense Exceptional Civilian Service Medal in 2008, He has appeared on 60 Minutes, Dan Rather Reports, ABC News with Charles Gibson, ABC News with Brian Ross The McNeil-Leher Report, CNN, Fox News Network, and the British Broadcast Corporation among others, and has been quoted in The Wall Street Journal, Washington Post, New York Times, Los Angeles Times, News Week, USA Today, Washington Times.

On Tuesday, March 25, 2014 **Ambassador Carol A. Rodley** was the distinguished speaker at the World Affairs Council of Palm Beach meeting at the Mar-a-Lago Club Palm Beach. Ambassador Rodley spoke to a full audience on the critical issue of Combating Human Trafficking: How Do We Protect the Vulnerable? She was U.S. Ambassador to Cambodia

from 2008 -2011, and shared many



personal experiences she had there, especially in learning the extent of child trafficking both for prostitution and for labor slavery. Children as young as 3 or 4 years of age are sold and imprisoned for years either as sex slaves or chained to chairs and made to work endlessly. Often these little children are disabled and sent on the streets to beg. Ambassador Rodley said that, with the help of our government and other global governments, homes and schools are now being built to assist and nurture those who are able to escape their "prisons". Laws are slowly being enacted to protect the innocent.

Ambassador Rodley has more than 30 years of experience as an American diplomat, and was the first Counselor for Political Military Affairs at the U.S. Embassy in Kabul in 2006-2007. Most recently, she served as Dean of the School of Leadership and Management at the State Department's Foreign Service Institute.

Ambassador Carol A. Rodley has just been named **Director** of Resolution to Act Initiative at Inclusive Security. Resolution to Act provides support and expertise to countries creating and implementing high-impact National Action Plans for Women, Peace, and Security.

Ambassador Rodley is the recipient of the State Department's Human Rights and Democracy Award, the American Foreign Service Association's Christian Herter Award for creative dissent, the James Clement Dunn Award for leadership, and a Presidential Performance award.





MorseLife dedicated Palm Beach County's newest short-term rehabilitation center - the Sondra and David S. Mack Pavilion – on the MorseLife campus on Haverhill Road. The 100,000 square foot, 120-bed Pavilion was the first of **three projects** costing \$50 million dollars with over \$22 million dollars raised to date through the generosity of donors to the **nonprofit's** Campaign to Transform MorseLife. The Mack Pavilion is named for Sondra and David S. Mack, lead donors for the Campaign and long-time supporters of MorseLife. The Mack Pavilion includes a 6,500 square foot therapy suite, six 'neighborhoods' of 20 private rooms, dining room and lounging areas.
