CAMBER RANSOM

Camber Ransom lives in Towaco, NJ and is married to **Sean Quigley** and is mom to two young daughters, **Madison** & Chelsea

Camber is owner of a Billboard Outdoor Advertising Company, CMS Consulting Group which is also headquartered in New Jersey.

Camber's involvement in **Stroke Awareness and Prevention** started when she saw her father suffer from a severe stroke at a young age and was never able to fully recover or live a full active life.

After meeting **Janet**, hearing her story and seeing her amazing and inspirational recovery from a major stroke, **Camber** decided that she wanted to become more involved in bringing awareness to the remarkable physicians and research being done at the **University of Miami**, **Department of Neurology** to not only help stroke victims but all others afflicted by devastating neurological diseases.

Camber has been on the committee for two years for the University of Miami's "**Solving the Neurological Puzzle**" Gala.

JANET LEVY

Janet had a major stroke in 2002. She had gone to a chiropractor and he ripped an artery by doing a chiropractic manipulation. Janet ended up having emergency brain surgery as the clot had lodged in her cerebellum. "When I awoke from surgery I was completely paralyzed. To open your eyes and not be able to move is a frightening experience. Less than two weeks earlier my life had been completely normal yet here I was unable to move. I was angry, scared, and panicked at the thought that this was it for me. How could this have happened from simply sleeping wrong on a new pillow and visiting a chiropractor?"

Within a few days she had regained limited use of her right side but was extremely weak. After six weeks in the hospital and a rehab facility, **Janet** was able to barely walk with a quad cane and her left arm was just "dead weight". The prognosis was not good as the doctors predicted that she would never walk normally again. While she might not have been wheelchair bound, she

would certainly have to use a quad cane for the rest of her life.

About 6 months after her stroke, she was taken to New York to see one of the country's leading neurologists.

Dr. Ralph Sacco. It was a huge pivotal time for her as she had been working so hard at her recovery but progress was very slow which led to much depression and frustration. Dr. Sacco

was smart, kind, empathetic and inspiring. He assured her she

was on the right path and gave needed encouragement and recommendations that helped greatly with her progress. After two years of a grueling schedule of therapies, **Janet** was able to get her life back. "Even though my balance is still off, I experience head pain most of the time and have weakness in my extremities, I am so fortunate and grateful that I am alive and could carry on a normal life."

Years later, **Dr. Ralph Sacco** was lured by University of Miami's President, **Donna Shalala** to head their Department

of Neurology. **Janet** was most impressed with the work **Dr. Sacco** and his team were doing for research and care for Stroke, Alzheimer's. Parkinson's ALS, Epilepsy and other devastating neurological diseases that she immediately signed up to support and raise awareness that such a great facility as the University of Miami is just an hour and a half away from Palm Beach.





With paddles shaped like wine goblets, guests found it easy to raise a glass for the spirited bidding during the **Seventh Annual Palm Beach Wine Auction** on Thursday, January 30 at The Mar-a-Lago Club, Palm Beach. Nearly 200 arts patrons and oenophiles toasted to record-breaking funds for the award-winning education programs at the **Kravis Center for the Performing Arts**.

Under the direction of Michael Troise, retired Auction Director for NY Wines/Christie's Fine and Rare Wine Department and an expert with more than 40 years' experience tasting, buying and brokering wines, the live auction segment of the evening nearly doubled funds raised from last year.

In its seventh year, the **Palm Beach Wine Auction** event has uncorked more than \$2 million to provide children in our region with an introduction to the arts, which they might not otherwise have had an opportunity to experience. **The Kravis Center**'s education programs have served nearly 2 million children of all ages over the past 21 years.

"It is often said that our most valuable resource is our children," said Palm Beach Wine Auction chairman and founder, **Ted Mandes**. "At the Kravis Center, the development and education of future audiences has always been top priority."

In addition to the cases and magnums of rare and very special wines, other offerings resulted in bidding battles as well. Included was a stunning Rolex Yacht-Master II donated by **Mayors**Jewelers-- a steal at \$15,000, and for her, an 18kt yellow gold Peretti bone cuff and cabochon green jade ring donated by **Tiffany & Co.** went for \$12,500.

Following a reception featuring **Krug Grande Cuvée** champagne and charcuterie by the **Chicago Omni Hotel's Joshua Hasho**, five delicious courses gave guests an opportunity to peruse the auction catalogue and strategize bidding on their favorite lots.

Once seated, an amuse bouche of sunchoke tart with house smoked Verlasso salmon, pink peppercorn crème fraîche and micro arugula was presented by **Chef Douglas Katz** from Cleveland's Fire Food and Drink, The Katz Club Diner and Provenance at the Cleveland Museum of Art.

A first course of Hamachi with muscadine jus, celery, pine nuts and nasturtium was prepared by **Chef Andrew Carmellini**, from The Dutch at W South Beach. **Chef Zach Bell** from Boca Raton's Addison Reserve Country Club and **Chef Lindsay Autry** double teamed to present the second course of open blue cobia with flavors of Provence and gratin of celery root and Florida stone crab.

The entrée of porcini-crusted prime beef tenderloin and burgundy braised beef chuck was accompanied by truffle parsnip purée, candied fennel, cipollini and confit tomato, and presented by master of the house, **The Mar-a-Lago Club**'s own **Chef Aaron Fuller**.

Chef Hasho then returned to prepare a cheese course of Mindoro smoked gorgonzola profiterole, triple cream panna cotta, beet variations and ursinus major aged sheep's milk with charred cashew butter.

Dessert featured another at-home The Mar-a-Lago Club superstar, **Chef Graham Randall**, overseeing the pistachio and white chocolate pavé with crème chantilly, strawberry gelato and pistachio sabayon.
