AWARDS \$36.5 MILLION AT 2011 SYMPOSIUM AND LUNCHEON

At The Breast Cancer Research Foundation (BCRF) Annual Symposium and Awards Luncheon on Wednesday, October 26, BCRF awarded \$36.5 million in grants to 186 investigators from the best scientific institutions across the United States, Canada, Latin America, Europe, the Middle East, Australia and Asia. Approximately 1,200 guests attended the Waldorf-Astoria to raise nearly \$2 million at the event.

The Jill Rose Award for outstanding research excellence honored Mina J. Bissell, PhD (Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory), The Sandra Taub Humanitarian Award was presented to Richard Anderson, CEO of Delta Air Lines, by Kenneth Chenault, Chairman and CEO of American Express, for his leadership in raising awareness of breast cancer around the globe and supporting lifesaving research.



In his spare time he serves as Treasurer of the Palm Beach Opera and The Palm Beach Round Table.




