### Monaco Red Cross Ball Friday, 5 August 2011, Salle des Étoiles - Sporting Monte-Carlo













Under the Presidency of His Serene Highness Prince Albert II and in the presence of Her Serene Highness Princess Charlene and the Princely Family, the Monaco Red Cross Ball took place on Friday 5 August in the Salle des Étoiles at the Sporting Monte-Carlo. For the 2011 edition, Joe Cocker performed at this celebration of the 63rd anniversary of the charity founded in 1948 by His Serene Highness Prince Louis II.

The Monaco Red Cross commitment continues to grow over the years; it is based on the fundamental principles of humanity and impartiality applied to the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement of which it is part. In 2011, 35 000 hours and more than 600,000 Euros were spent on international aid and nearly

700,000 Euros on community care in the Principality and the adjacent towns. The funds, coming from donations and bequests, are in part made up of money raised during the Annual Ball.

This year, the work of art traditionally donated to the Monaco Red Cross to support its humanitarian operations, is called "Collection Mondo" by Peter Wüthrich.

The tombola, boasting fabulous prizes were hold by Sandrine Quétier and Dame Shirley Bassey welcomed the guests of the Gala. A magnificent firework brought this exceptional event to a truly dazzling end.





### THE 2011 ALZHEIMER'S ASSOCIATION Rita Hayworth Gala


October 25, 2011 | Waldorf Astoria Hotel, New York

Alzheimer's is the 6th leading cause of death in the United States and an estimated 5.4 million Americans are living with this disease. With the continued support of generous donors, the Alzheimer's Association strives for a world without Alzheimer's, funding research that will lead to earlier identification of Alzheimer's and therapies that will one day slow or stop the progression of this fatal disease, all while providing individuals and families impacted with care and support resources. 


