Between early morning swims and evening campfires, children whose lives have been a series of medical procedures and hospital stays are transformed into just "kids." They have a chance to be with others coping with the same illness or condition and realize that they are not alone.

The prescription for the day is fun, fun, fun! Laughter, giggles, friendships and excitement abound on the **232 acres** of tall pines, majestic oaks and nature trails. Campers are empowered to do things they never dreamed they could do. They are infused with a spirit of accomplishment at every turn and allowed to forget that "they have what they have." For many of them it is the first time they've felt "normal" since their diagnosis. Programs at **Camp Boggy Creek** include week long summer sessions as well as family retreat weekends and each includes full medical coverage with on site professionals in the illness specialty being served.

During each of our summer sessions, up to 150 children with like illnesses arrive for a week of fun, adventure and independence.

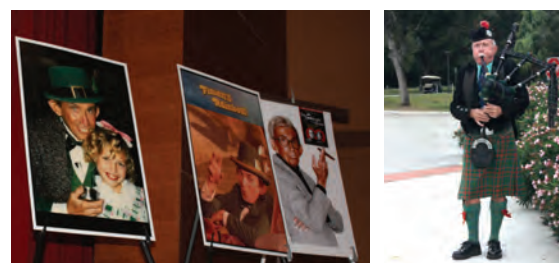
